

## Vignettes

### 3 hypothetical scenarios

Cancer



Mild depression

Severe depression

You have been suffering from insomnia for the past few weeks, which has left you exhausted. You have dark thoughts and overwhelming feelings of hopelessness, which have increased since your last visit to the family doctor. You decide to consult your family doctor again. After a thorough examination, you are diagnosed with major depressive disorder. The discusses treatment options, such as starting antidepressants, psychotherapy and possibly admission to a psychiatric hospital.

## **MEASURES**

#### The role of your family in MDM

- 1. I will make a decision with little or no input from my family
- 2. I will make a decision after considering my family's opinion
- 3. My family and I will make a decision together
- 4. My family will make a decision after considering my opinion
- 5. My family makes the decision

Low family involvement (more or less alone)

High family involvement

→ based on the Control Preference Scale


#### Medical decision-making module

- Survey time: +/- 5 min
- During the panel build-up phase
- Sent to a subsample of TSS: +/- 1600 respondents
- Final sample of 1175 completed surveys
- Access to all other variables

## RESULTS (I): Desired level of family involvement in MDM

Majority of respondents prefer to decide more or less alone

- Type of disease
  cancer vs. depression
  (mcNemar's test, within individuals)
  More preference for FI in depression vignette
- Severity of disease
  mild vs. severe depression
  (Chi2-tests, between individuals)
  More preference for FI in severe depression vignette


